Infinity is the fragile limit of our inner Freedom

Focusing on the theme of freedom, the author takes us on a journey from her early political experience as an anti-fascist fighter to the core of psychoanalytic experience and the depths of the unconscious.

Starting from the primordial myths that have shaped religious, moral and ethical thought, she takes us through the ages to its most intimate inner formulation, drawing on the testimony of thinkers such as Freud, Ferenczi, Winnicott, Bion and Matte-Blanco.

It focuses on the essential role of freedom and affection, both in the daily lives of individuals and in their relationship with society, emphasising the reciprocal relationship between them.

It questions the role of the psychoanalyst in this duality as he attempts to maintain his difficult neutrality within aesthetic and ethical parameters in an increasingly dystopian world.
