Abstract:

In this presentation three perspectives of ethical issues in psychoanalytic training will be discussed: the standards of general accepted professional conduct, the specificity of the psychoanalytical situation and the ethical dimension of misconduct, transgressions and treatment errors. The core of a psychoanalytic culture of error and mistakes will need to include responsibility and ambiguity tolerance. The challenge to discriminate neutrality and confidentiality from defensive secrecy in the analytic situation in training will be discussed in detail with clinical examples. A special focus will be on supervision in training.
