## **Abstract Content (EN)**

“In mutual collegial encounters between different institutes/societies self-reflection of institutes/societies will be stimulated and thereby enhance the quality of psychoanalytic education. Discussing questions of training in a collegial atmosphere during encounters of two or three institutes creates an open space for reflection on training and learning from each other. Open space - “Neutrality” is understood in this context as opening a room for a third perspective nourished by the respect for the other and a renunciation to dominate others or wanting to shape them according to ones own standards. In this mutual exchange of ideas and experiences, not only problems become more visible and can consequently be worked through, but also strengths and creative solutions can be transferred to each other and thereby enhance mutual learning by experience.”
