GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION

Registration

Fees are per person and plus 19 % value added tax charged on behalf of CSi Hamburg GmbH (Office: Goernestraße 30, 20249 Hamburg/Germany, taxpayer ID number: DE290349357). Participants paying by credit card* will receive a written confirmation and a separate form for the transmission of credit card data. Participants paying by bank transfer or by invoice will receive a confirmation with paying details. Registration fees have to be paid within 14 days, otherwise the registration will be cancelled.

Cancellation

Intentions to cancel must be submitted in writing to meetings@csihamburg.de. In case of cancellation received before 8 January 2024, 50 % of the registration fee will be reimbursed, less 25 € net service charge. No refund thereafter. All refunds will be settled after the event. Substitutions will be accepted at any time and will be charged at 15.00 EUR incl. VAT handling fee. Name changes received 2 weeks or less prior to the start of the course will be charged 15.00 EUR incl. VAT. All changes or cancellations must be submitted in writing to CSi Hamburg GmbH.

INVOICE ADJUSTMENT OR CHANGE

Each invoice adjustment or change will be charged with 15.00 EUR incl. VAT.

PAYMENT TARGET / PAYMENT DELAY

Registrations without payment within 2 weeks after invoicing (the date of issue counts) will incur a reminder fee 10.00 EUR, which must be paid in any case. Registrations, further 2 weeks without payment after receipt of the reminder fee, are considered cancelled and the place will be given to colleagues on the waiting list. The reminder fee must be paid in any case. These fees are independent of the regular cancellation fees.

Data use and storage

The personal data you provide will only be used by CSi Hamburg GmbH to fulfil the contract and will be handled in accordance with the provisions of the German Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO). For the duration of the contractual relationship, the service provider may store and use your personal data in compliance with the applicable data protection regulations. The collection, storage and processing of your personal data is necessary for your registration for the offer. Your data will be used exclusively for the purpose of organising and conducting the event. Your data will only be passed on to third parties if they are directly involved in the running of the event and if the organisational progress makes this necessary (organizer, course director). The legislative body requires to obtain your active consent. You will receive information about the data we have stored about you without having to give a reason and you can have this data blocked, corrected or deleted at any time. You can also revoke your consent to the use of your data at any time without giving reasons.
